Chief of Police Braintree, Massachusetts

Location: The Town of Braintree is a thriving residential/commercial community on the Massachusetts coast about twelve miles south of Boston. Its population of 35,000 swells to 100,000 daily due to its location which makes it a transportation hub as well as a suburb of Boston. There has been a Mayor/Council form of government since 2008. The Police Department is comprised of 75 sworn personnel and 16 civilian employees, 9 of which are civilian dispatchers, in addition to 24 school traffic supervisors and 13 special police officers.

Position: The Braintree Police Chief is appointed by the Mayor and reports to the Mayor through the Chief of Staff/Director of Operations. The Police Chief will direct an established department with an annual budget of almost eight million dollars. The salary range is \$105,333 - \$123,225 plus benefits.

Qualifications: Evidence of strong leadership, management and organizational skills are essential. The successful candidate must have a familiarity and working knowledge of labor relations and the collective bargaining process. The ability to actively work with the community and related social agencies is also required. Candidates must possess a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. A master's degree or advanced training in law enforcement management is preferred. Applicants must have a minimum of ten years of progressively responsible experience in a law enforcement agency, five of which have been in an administrative or command position.
