Said funds are to be expended under the direction of the Community Preservation Committee and by the Director of Planning and Community Development. 11 046 Mayor: In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 44B of the General Laws and with the recommendation of the Community Preservation Committee, that the sum of \$25,000.00 be appropriated from the Community Preservation Act Historic reserve account for the purpose of funding Phase II of the Old Thayer Assessment & Master Plan proposed by the Braintree Historical Commission subject to quarterly reporting on the project's progress to the Community Preservation Committee.
