Councilor Clifford expressed his opposition to presenting this order to the Committee. He sees no reason for increasing the meals tax. Councilor DeNapoli concurred with Councilor Clifford.

Councilor Kokoros stated he did not support the increase in meals tax. He explained, unlike the Hotel/Motel Tax, this increase tax would impact small business and residents.

Councilor Dingee stated, at this time he has not taken a position on this order. He explained, the reason the order is before the Council is to send it to Committee to be reviewed and to make a recommendation. It allows the means for holding a public hearing on the subject and allows the council to get input from residents.

Councilor Mullaney explained that there is a need for addition funds next fiscal year. The Town lost 675 Thousand Dollars in Local aid and did not fill various positions to make up that shortfall.

It is anticipated that the Town will lose additional Local Aid this upcoming fiscal year. The added funding from this .75% increase in the meals tax could be used to support the schools and public safety. This order should go before committee for study.

Councilor Joyce and Councilor Bowes agreed that the order should go before committee for study and to allow the public to weigh-in on the issue.
