ORDER NO. 08 032C – Revolving Funds

INTRODUCED: MAYOR

RE-AUTHORIZATION OF REVOLVING FUNDS

Upon request of his Honor, Mayor Sullivan, the Town of Braintree, through the Braintree Town Council approved that the Council on Aging be authorized to use a Revolving Fund in accordance with the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 44, Section 53E1/2 that may be spent by the Council on Aging without further appropriation during the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2008, to pay salaries, expenses and contractual services required to provide services and activities for the Town's elderly residents. The Council on Aging Revolving Fund is to be credited with all fees and charges received during Fiscal Year 2009 from persons using said programs. The Council on Aging may spend up to \$30,000 in Revolving Fund monies during Fiscal Year 2009.

That the Board of Health be authorized to use a Revolving Fund in accordance with the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 44, Section 53E1/2 that may be spent by the Board of Health without further appropriation during the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2008, for the costs associated with purchasing and administering public health immunizations. The Board of Health Revolving Fund is to be credited with all fees and charges collected during Fiscal Year 2009 for immunizations administered under the Department of Public Health. The Board of Health may spend up to \$40,000 in Revolving Fund monies during Fiscal Year 2009.

That the Library Trustees be authorized to use a Revolving Fund in accordance with the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 44, Section 53E1/2 that may be spent by the Library Trustees without further appropriation during the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2008, for the purchase of library books and audiovisual materials. The Library Trustees Revolving Fund is to be credited with all fines and fees collected during Fiscal Year 2009. The Library Trustees may spend up to \$40,000 in Revolving Fund monies during Fiscal Year 2009.

That the Mayor be authorized to use a Revolving Fund in accordance with the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 44, Section 53E1/2 that may be spent by the Mayor, in conjunction with the Recycling Coordinator, without further appropriation during the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2008, for the purchase of home composting bins, curbside recycling bins, recycling bags and for the collection of fees and payments for recycling materials, including hazardous waste. The Recycling Revolving Fund is to be credited with all fees collected during Fiscal Year 2009. The Mayor may spend up to \$5,000 in Revolving Fund monies during Fiscal Year 2009.

That the Mayor be authorized to use a Revolving Fund in accordance with the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 44, Section 53E1/2 that may be spent by the Mayor, in conjunction with the Recycling Coordinator without further appropriation during the Fiscal Year Commencing July 1, 2008, for the collection of fees and payments from the collection of revenue-generating materials and to use the income to promote Town recycling initiatives and events, including household hazardous waste events. The Recycling Revolving Fund is to be credited with all fees collected during Fiscal Year 2009. The Mayor may spend up to \$35,000 in Revolving Fund monies during Fiscal Year 2009.

That the School Committee be authorized to use a Revolving Fund in accordance with the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 44, Section 53E1/2 that may be spent by the School Committee without further appropriation during the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2008 for the operation of extra curricular activities. The School Department Revolving Fund is to be credited with all fees and charges from all extra curricular activities collected during Fiscal Year 2009 from students engaging in such activities. The School Committee may spend up to \$100,000 in Revolving Fund monies in Fiscal Year 2009.

That the School Committee be authorized to use a Revolving Fund in accordance with the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 44, Section 53E1/2 that may be spent by the School Committee without further appropriation during the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2008, for the operation of school bus transportation services. The Revolving Fund is to be credited with all school bus fees and charges collected during Fiscal Year 2009. The School Committee may spend up to \$175,000 in Revolving Fund monies in Fiscal Year 2009.
