Frequently Asked Questions:

WHAT DO I DO ABOUT MISSED PICKUPS?

MISSED PICKUPS, CALL SUNRISE SCAVENGER AT 617-361-8000

Will wood be picked up?

Only if cut into 4 ft. lengths & tied. Up to 3 bundles weekly allowed. **NO WOOD** is allowed in carts. Pallets are not collected curbside or at the Recycling Center Dropoff.

What is the procedure for appliance, mattress, & box spring pickup?

Residents should call Sunrise Scavenger 617-361-8000 prior to trash day to advise that these items are being put out. Mattresses & box springs now must be collected separately and recycled instead of going into the trash per Dept. of Environmental Protection, as of 11-1-22.

What is the process for bulk items (furniture)?

Two pieces of furniture may be put out per week. No need to call. Separate truck will collect later in the day.

What do I do about construction material?

Doors, windows, toilets, fencing, etc. are not picked up curbside. It must be disposed of through the contractor doing the work or by taking it to companies such as Champion City/Brockton or Boston Building Materials (Habitat for Humanity who will pick up re-usable items at no charge).
