


# Shagbark Hickory

Shagbark Hickory (*Carya ovata*) has distinctively shaggy bark which makes it one of the easier trees to identify while out on a woods walk. Shagbark hickory is in the Walnut family and makes a delicious tasting nut, enjoyed by both humans and wildlife. Shagbark hickories reach maturity and start producing nuts around 40 years old.
