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The Braintree Police Department seeks to provide innovative and effective outreach programs to the residents of Braintree. The Junior Academy is designed with the intent to establish a positive relationship between the Police Department and Braintree Youth.

Braintree residents, attending school, having completed the 6th grade and enrolling into the 7th grade, are eligible to attend.

The goals of the academy are:

- Enhance responsible citizenship
- Provide a positive interaction with police officers
- Educate youth about the challenges and responsibilities of police work

The Braintree Police Department will host a one week 2019 Junior Police Academy consisting of five (5) days, Monday through Friday. The Academy will be held at South Middle School. The Program will open at 8:30 a.m. and dismissal will be at 2:00 p.m. Students will attend classroom sessions with lectures, role-plays and demonstrations by police officers in the areas of law, drug awareness and first responder skills. Field trips are also part of the curriculum. Transportation to and from the field trips will be provided. Students will be required to bring their own lunch and snack daily. Students should wear comfortable athletic attire and sneakers (comfortable for running).

Students will be issued 2 Academy uniform shirts, 2 shorts, an academy baseball cap and an Academy water bottle. The uniform will be the mandatory uniform of the day.

The Academy Class will commence on:

Monday, **August 12th** and end on Friday, **August 16th**

Completed Applications may be submitted to the Assistant Principal Elaine Pagliarulo at South Middle School, Assistant Principal Andrew Curran at East

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Middle School or they may be dropped off at Braintree Police with attention to Officer Peter Gillis.

If needed, a lottery drawing will be held at each respective school in late May by their respective Principal. The announcement will be made at the school. Email notification will also be sent to email addresses provided in the application packets for both the selected and non-selected students.

Upon acceptance into the program, each student will be notified of a 1 hour orientation the week prior to the academy start from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Parents/Guardians are required to come with their Students.

A general overview of the program will be presented and there will be time for Q/A.
