### **Town of Braintree Basketball Courts** *Effective Immediately*

These guidelines shall be posted at all entrances/in clearly visible locations into the Town of Braintree basketball courts, and on the Town website/social media sites.

- 1) All visitors/users to the Town of Braintree basketball courts shall abide by the specific protocols outlined for use of these Town properties;
- 2) All visitors to Town of Braintree properties in which basketball courts are located shall comply with COVID-19 Order 31: Order Requiring Face Coverings in Public Places Where Social Distancing is Not Possible, which requires any person over the age of 2, whether indoors or outdoors, to wear a face covering or mask when they cannot maintain 6 feet of distance between themselves and others, unless they have a medical condition preventing them from doing so;
- 3) Group Size: No groups larger than 10 are allowed to gather in any one location on Town of Braintree properties in which basketball courts are located;
- 4) All visitors/users shall always practice social distancing by remaining 6 feet away from others and adhering to all site-specific rules, regulations, and posted signage regarding permitted uses;
- 5) Users of the basketball courts should sanitize their hands before and after play, not share equipment and clean and wipe down equipment, including balls, and water bottles;
- 6) Users waiting to utilize a basketball court should wait outside the court's gates/fence until previous users have vacated the facility to ensure proper social distancing;
- 7) Visitors/users should not congregate outside of the court's gate/fence to avoid overcrowding;
- 8) Scrimmages, organized games and tournaments are not permitted in Phase II of the Reopening Plan, and activities must be limited to no-contact drills and training exercises;
- 9) Trash Disposal: Visitors/users of the Town of Braintree properties in which basketball courts are located should expect limited or no trash disposal receptacles. When visiting Town properties without trash receptacles, visitors shall adhere to a strict "carry in, carry out" policy and take waste with them. Where trash receptacles are available for normal use, visitors shall properly dispose of trash using the trash receptacles provided;
- 10) Loitering on Town properties is prohibited; and
- 11) This guidance shall apply until amended or rescinded.
