Fall Yard Waste Collection 2020

Weeks of: Oct. 19 & 26, Nov. 2, 9, 16, 23 & Week of Nov. 30th is the final week.

Curbside yard waste will be picked up on your regular trash day. **Please have curbside prior to 7AM.**

Place leaves, grass clippings & twigs (less than 1") into brown paper leaf bags, or open barrels (no lids please).

Plastic bags will be rejected curbside, but can be **emptied out** at 225 Plain St. (Drop-Off Compost Site). Branches & shrubs can be dropped off also, but no rootballs. The site is open Wed. - through Sun. 7:15AM - 2:45PM from mid-April - Jan. 31, 2021. Due to warm weather may be open extra days prior to April. Call 781-794-8955 for information. **Trash Sticker Required.**
