Response to Ways & Means Committee questions

1. \$100,000 ADA Compliance Issues

a.) The documented needs assessment used as the basis of the scope of work to be undertaken by this specific allocation request

The Department will continue to work with the DPW (Engineering Division, Highway Division and Facilities Division) and ADA Coordinator to identify Town wide needs for enhanced accessibility. Locations for improvements will also consider planned capital projects, resident requests and the finalization for approval of the ADA transition plan.

b.) The scope of work to be undertaken

As noted in these responses, this work will be performed in collaboration with DPW and the ADA Coordinator and are not limited to one specific project type or work. At present, the Department is working with the Facilities Department to construct accessible walkways into the bathhouse at Sunset Lake and to complete an analysis of the handicapped ramp into Cahill Auditorium. Additionally, the Department will work with DPW on ADA accessible projects including the reconstruction of curb access ramps, accessibility of Town buildings, pedestrian safety devices, audible crosswalk signals and walk surface repairs.

c.) Any and all related cost analysis work performed that was utilized as the basis of determining the full project costs to be undertaken in this stated scope of work

The funds requested do not contemplate one specific project. Instead, working directly with the DPW (Engineering Division, Highway Division and Facilities Division) and the ADA Coordinator, it is part of a yearly investment to ensure the highest level of accessibility for all of our residents throughout the Town.
