REQUEST OF: NATIONAL GRID

National Grid hereby respectfully requests your consent to the locations of mains as hereinafter described for the transmission and distribution of gas in and under the following public streets, lanes, highways, and places of the Town of Braintree and of the pipes, valves, governors, manholes and other structures, fixtures and appurtenances designed or intended to protect or operate said mains and accomplish the objects of said Company; and the digging up and opening the ground to lay or place same:

National Grid hereby requests to relay approximately 480 feet of 2-inch bare steel (1926/1946), approximately 25 feet of 3-inch plastic (1979), and approximately 75 feet of 2-inch plastic (1978), with approximately 580 feet of 2-inch plastic in Standish Ave, from Arbutus Ave. to the end of main at #118 Standish Ave. with Staff Recommendations:

BELD: has no conflicts with location.

DPW: The DPW has reviewed the subject petition and the accompanying sketch for the gas main replacement on Standish Ave. The work is being proposed as part of a program to eliminate aging gas infrastructure. Standish Avenue is not subject to the excavation moratorium, having been last resurfaced by overlay and microsurfacing in 2012. However, the condition of the roadway pavement is still in good condition and as such, the DPW recommends that the petition be so granted with the following conditions:

- A temporary patch shall be placed immediately after the work. The street excavation should be sawcut, backfilled and compacted in 8-inch lifts, paved to match existing asphalt depth (with a minimum depth of four inches) in two-inch lifts to match the existing street grade.
- After maintaining the temporary patch through one winter, a permanent patch shall be placed the following spring. The permanent patch shall be a curb-to-crown mill and overlay with a pavement depth 1.5 inches.



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We also recommend that the following requirements be added to the permit, if it is to be granted:

- National Grid must arrange a pre-construction meeting with Braintree the DPW to discuss utility corridor assignment. The new gas mains must not encroach on any existing utilities.
- Neither National Grid nor any of its contractors is authorized to close any street or to close a direction of travel to facilitate their work without authorization from the Director of the Department of Public Works or the Highway Superintendent. The Chief of Police can also authorize a closure for a police or fire emergency. Construction zone traffic safety issues are to be addressed by using appropriate traffic control signs and devices and the use of police officers for traffic control to safely guide traffic through the work zone. If a closure is authorized by the DPW, it shall not be implemented until signs and police officers (where needed) are properly in place in conformity with the written plan prepared by the contractor's engineer and approved by the DPW and Police Department.
